



### Trade Association Memberships and Dues

EOG participates in various state and national trade associations, which provide technical expertise, set standards to improve industry operations, and monitor legislative and regulatory changes, in addition to advocacy. The Nominating, Governance and Sustainability Committee of EOG’s Board of Directors reviews and assesses, at least annually, EOG’s trade association memberships and dues. Pursuant to its Political Activities and Trade Associations Policy, EOG discloses (i) the trade association memberships for which its annual dues equal or exceed \$50,000 and (ii) the amount of dues paid to each such trade association for such year.
